1st Annual Doodle Spiel

After several years of discussion, positive steps were taken to hold an annual {we hope} curling event for the C.S.E.G. Three eminent bonspieler from the C.S.E.G. were designated to take on the task of organizing the first 'spiel; namely, Joe Prendergast {lead}, Ben Berg {non-curler}, and Ed Rutledge {non-curler}. After some preliminary meetings and the arranging of ice in Banff, it was decided that a larger committee would be necessary to complete the organization of the 'spiel. Accordingly, the committee presently active in organizing the first Doodle 'Spiel is: Chairman Joe Prendergast; Draw Masters Jake Hudson and Bob Page; Financial Directors Ben Berg and Ed Rutledge; Prizes and Entertainment Tom Somerville.

Entry forms were sent out in the November C.S.E.G. newsletter for submission after December 24th, 1972. The dates of the bonspiel are February 2nd to 4th, 1973 at the Banff Recreation Rink. Accomodation has been arranged at the Timberline Hotel. The bonspiel fee per curler is sixty dollars {~~\$60.00~~}, which includes curling costs, prizes, accomodation, meals and a cocktail party and banquet on the Saturday.

The pre-application verbal response to the idea from the membership at large was such that the committee considered it necessary to make in advance certain regulations which would govern the selection of rinks and curlers should there be an over-subscription. As it turned out, the bonspiel is under subscribed and we have relaxed the entry regulations in order to make sure that the event takes place.

Although the response was somewhat disappointing, we are hopeful that sufficient good publicity will result from the 'spiel itself that the succeeding years will present no problem. In this regard, reservations have been made for 1974 at the Banff curling facility and the Timberline Hotel.
